Out of England comes the Award winning clown – Fraser Hooper, the Cloghoppers Banjo Circus and the Chipolatas, bringing the global and local experience into one magical package.

Add to that an extraordinary line-up of world class trapeze artists, dancers, magicians, musicians, jugglers, visual artists, whip crackers, unicyclists and comedians and you have a not to be missed Festival.
