This half man/half demon evolved from the subconscious is on a mission to: charm, disarm, shock and seduce in a critically-acclaimed performance as America's premier jester, or to use the French theatrical term, bouffon.

Bouffon characters are a modern-day interpretation of the satyr – a half-man, half-animal character found in Greek mythology and the subversive, paradic farce of theatre of ancient Rome.

Described by Irish Theatre Magazine as: "One funny son of a b*tch", Red Bastard is an incredible mover, master of improvisation and self-proclaimed provocateur. Who, with exquisite monstrosity, employs charm and biting wit to playfully manipulate his audience.

Created by actor, writer and director Eric Davis, Red Bastard is pure genius from a man who is lauded as one of the premier clowns of our time. As founder and co-director of the NY Clown Theatre, his performance credits include the clown in the highly celebrated production of Quidam.

Practitioner and teacher of improvisation, movement, Lecoq technique and mask for over 15 years, look out for the Red Bastard lurking the streets of Fremantle during Australia's largest Street Arts Festival.
